

## Dress Code

Your school uniform confirms your attendance at the school and is a symbol of unity within the school community. It minimizes distractions in the learning process. It is important that you take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete uniform always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school you are representing the school and your behavior should be a credit to both yourself and the school community. **Please see Flynn O'Hara website for pictures of each item; [www.flynnohara.com](http://www.flynnohara.com)**

### Dress Uniform:

- Girls K - 4 Green, plaid split front jumper, white blouse (*long or short sleeve*) with round (*peter pan*) collar (*no frill on edges allowed*), and navy V-neck cardigan w/ school logo. K - 4 girls **DO NOT** wear polo shirts.
- Girls 5 – 8.....Green, plaid skirt to the knee and white convertible collar (long or short sleeve) blouse with pointed collar, and navy V-neck pullover sweater. Spring/Fall polo w/ school logo shirt may be worn on dates noted in calendar.
- Girls K – 8.....All girls must wear navy blue knee high socks or tights, black or navy shoes. **Sneaker-type shoes are not permitted**; no high top shoes, moccasins or boots are allowed. Post earrings (*no larger than our standard pencil top eraser*) or small hoops (*no larger than a dime*) permitted in lobe **only**. **No makeup** is allowed and only **clear or sheer** nail polish is permitted. Girls may wear simple barrettes or headbands in hair.
- Boys K - 4:.....Navy dress uniform trousers (*see Flynn O'Hara Uniform site; corduroys or Dockers, or baggies*), white dress shirt (*gr 1- 4 only*). Light blue polo shirt for K (long or short sleeve), black/brown shoes, no sneaker type shoes or boots are permitted, navy cardigan, plaid tie (*gr 1-4 only*), and belt (*gr 1-4*), K has option for elastic waist band pant (*no need for belt*). Spring/Fall polo shirt w/school logo may be worn on dates noted in calendar (*gr 1-4 only*), navy [or dark, solid] crew socks
- Boys 5 - 8:.....Navy dress uniform trousers (*see Flynn O'Hara Uniform site; no corduroys or Dockers, or baggies*), white dress shirt (long or short sleeves), black/brown shoes, no sneaker-type shoes or boots are permitted, sweater vest w/school logo, solid navy blue uniform tie, navy [or dark, solid] crew socks. Spring/Fall polo shirt w/ school logo may be worn on dates noted in calendar.
- \*\*Outerwear sold may not replace school sweater as part of dress uniform\*\***
- Boys K - 8:.....Jewelry **is not** permitted with the exception of a wristwatch.

### **Gym Uniform:**

Navy blue school uniform shorts or sweat pants and sweatshirt w/ school emblem, grey school tee-shirt and sweatshirt (new vendor TBD by September 2017). On the day the children have gym, they are to wear their gym uniforms to school. Students must wear sneakers on gym day. Grade 8 ONLY may wear their 8<sup>th</sup> grade Class of 2018 T-shirt once it arrives as well as acceptable school bottoms (no exercise tights or short shorts for girls or boys).

Girls & Boys:.....The presence of anything that proclaims a current fad is not permitted.

**\*\*During the cold weather, students may wear the navy blue uniform cardigan sweater only. Other types of sweaters or sweatshirts may not be worn.\*\***

### **Personal Appearance**

A good personal hygiene routine should be followed daily: ears, neck, and fingernails should be given special attention. When appropriate, children should be instructed in the use of deodorant.

Uniforms should be neat and clean.

Hair should be clean and well groomed:

**BOYS** - hair must not be below the shirt collar. Shaved designs are not permitted. Bangs should not be so long that they impede vision.

**GIRLS** – hair may not be dyed nor may colored hair extensions be added. Bangs should not be so long that they impede vision. Simple barrettes or headbands may be worn.

Parents will be notified if a child comes to school consistently in an unkempt manner. If no improvement is noticed within a reasonable amount of time, an appointment with the parents and with the guidance office as well as administration will be made by school officials.
